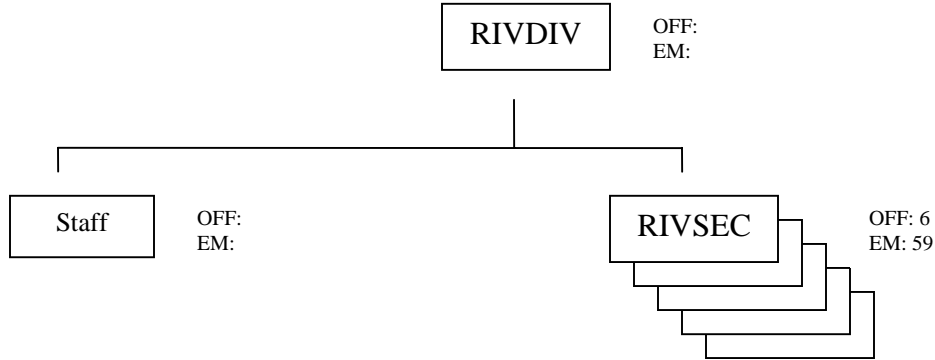


**US Navy River Division (December 1965 – December 1967)**

**NOTES:** This is the organization described for Task Force 116's River Divisions between December 1965 when Operation Game Warden began and when the Task Force was reorganized in January 1968. The number of River Sections was variable, with two Divisions with five sections as show here, two more with four sections, and one having only two sections. Each section was supposed to have a total of ten PBR Mk IIs, but this was likely variable. The standard crew of four was also likely variable. Each numbers and ranks for the staff in both the River Division and River Section were unspecified in the source.
